



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

FGC/C12' (Lap Pool)

REEL SYSTEM COMPONENTS AND PREPARATION:

Ensure your system has the quantity of cartons shown below, consisting of one end set and one tube set. 3 people make assembly easier.

Tools required for assembly:

- Electric drill
- Tape measure, pencil and scissors
- 7/13" wrench
- 3/4" wrench

Tube Carton check list:

C20 - 1 end carton and 1 tube carton 72lbs
C25 - 1 end carton and 2 tube cartons 83lbs
C30 - 1 end carton and 2 tube cartons 95lbs

C12 - 1 end carton and 1 tube carton 4



STEP 1: SOLAR REEL PLACEMENT:


A. Before assembling the reel, determine its best location on the pool (see Fig. 1). The end of the pool is most often the preferred location. On some pools, a mid-point location may be required to prevent dragging the blanket over the deck or avoid diving boards and ladders. Small blanket extensions may be folded in. Wall mounting is possible by removing the casters.

B. **Trim blanket to clear inside edges of pool by ½".** Upon completion of reel assembly and installation, give blanket a final trim.



FGC/C20 - Maximum recommended cover size - 20' x 125' (150lbs.) FGC/C25 - Maximum recommended cover size - 25' x 100' (150lbs.) FGC/C30 - Maximum recommended cover size - 30' x 80' (140lbs.) FGC/C12 - Maximum recommended cover size - 11' x 125' (82.5lbs.)



STEP 2: TUBE ASSEMBLY

A. At the reel placement location, measure the maximum width of cover. (Do NOT count pieces which may be folded in). Insert the smaller end tubes an equal distance into the center tube making sure that the end plugs are on the outside (see Fig. 2). Extend end tubes equally, approximately 1 foot longer than this cover width. Always ensure minimum insertion (see Fig. 4). Less than minimum insertion will cause tubes to loosen and/or split.



STEP 2: TUBE ASSEMBLY CONTINUED

Each tube join requires a total of 12 - #14 self-drilling screws. **Do not pre-drill holes** or over-tighten screws.



- B. Lock tubes together by rotating the center tube in the opposite direction to end tube. HOLD TUBES LOCKED WHILE YOU INSTALL 2 SELF-DRILLING SCREWS ON A DRILL LINE, 1" (2.5 cm) back from end of center tube at location "C1" (Fig. 5 & 6).
- C. Place 4 more self-drilling screws at Location "C2" and "C3" 2 screws at every second drill line around tubes (see Fig. 5).
- D. At "D" locations, install 6 screws around the center tube at every second drill line, 1" (2.5 cm) back from where you marked the end of the inner tube (see Fig. 5).
- E. Repeat for other end tube.

F. Insert 1 #12 self drilling screw approximately 1" from end of each end tube - through 'lip' of plug. (see Fig. 7)_


STEP 3: ASSEMBLE ENDS

- A Install the 4 locking casters into the "T" stands using nuts and washers provided.
- B. Insert the handle through the bearings in the stand.
- C. Then insert shaft into the plug in the end tube. Line up the hole in the plug with the hole in the shaft, insert the 1 1/2" x 1/4" bolt through both and tighten nut.
- D. REPEAT this step using axle shaft at the other end.

STEP 4: BLANKET ATTACHMENT


- A. Mark each end tube 6" (15 cm) in from the inside edge of top rail of pool. Strap plates are spaced evenly between these marks. Mark strap plate locations along drill lines. Use all straps provided.
- B. Attach a strap plate to each end of all straps (see Fig.9).
- C. Attach strap plates to tube (see Fig. 10). DO NOT pre-drill holes or over-tighten screws.
- D. Adjust strap lengths to roll up evenly.






The first strap plate is place 6" (15 cm) from the inside edge of the pool or at the start of the radius corner.

Attach cover end of strap to plate (see Fig. 9) then pierce hole through cover, 1" (2.5 cm) back from edge and directly below strap plate on tube. Push plastic screw through hole in cover and tighten snugly into plate.



Safe Use of Your Solar Reel:

- Solar Reel systems are designed solely to remove solar blankets and are not designed to support people or any other weight. They must be completely removed from the pool before entry into the pool.
- Under no circumstances, should one swim in a pool partially covered with the solar blanket.

Care and Storage:

Check screws periodically and tighten, if necessary. The solar reel may be stored outside for the winter. It is not recommended to disassemble it for storage inside.




